## Q.C. Inspection: New Home, New Machinery

As you all know by now the Inspection department has a new home being built in the old sheet metal room. What some of you may not know is, along with the other new machinery, MGI has purchased two new CMM's from Brown & Sharp. The machine that will go into the new inspection room is considerably larger than the old CMM series with significant enhancements. The machine is known as a "Global Performance 9.20.8 series" with overall strokes of 35.4" X, 78.7" Y & 31.4"Z .

The machine shop floor CMM is known as a "ONE" with overall strokes of 27.6"X, 39.4"Y & 25.6"Z. It is almost as large as the old RS-30 (Old CMM in the old inspection room) but with a considerably smaller footprint. Both machines have identical probe heads and probing systems, upgraded software PCDMIS and scanning capabilities.
